D	AMAGE PREVENTION Lubricate the moving parts
	\square Safeguard the battery; remove and charge or hookup to a battery tender
	☐ Check your coolant system for proper levels of anti-freeze
S1	TORAGE ☐ Move to a warm, dry place (i.e., garage or shed)
	☐ Protect the tires by keeping them off the ground with a motorcycle stand, slightly rotating them every few weeks, or putting a buffer between them and the ground
	☐ Cover the mufflers and plug the pipes
	☐ Properly cover the entire motorcycle
IN	ISURANCE □ Talk to your agent □ Ask if lay up policies are available in your area □ Ask about seasonal ratings
	☐ Consider storage insurance and theft protection
	☐ Take an inventory and check your policy for limits, exclusions, programs, and discounts
